Education Facilitator

(Contractual Position for one Year)

Reporting to the Executive Director, the successful candidate will facilitate education and awareness in the implementation of an anti-stigma program to adolescents and youth throughout the province primarily, but not solely, within the school environment. This initiative will utilize programs from CMHA National as well as similar programs developed elsewhere.

Duties:

Specific duties will include but not be limited to: liaison with the school system to initiate and implement education programs pertaining to mental health and mental illness; development and delivery of presentations on related topics to the adolescent population specifically and youth leaders generally; outreach to regions of the province and exploration of alternate methods for program delivery, including the internet, social media, etc.; perform a train-the-trainer role in appropriate programs; participate as required in special projects on mental health and mental illness awareness; organize and promote articles on mental health particularly focused on adolescents. Perform other related duties as required.

Qualifications:

Completion of post secondary education in the social sciences, education or a related area, or an equivalent combination of experience and education. Experience in the development and delivery of educational programs, preferably for adolescents. The ability to develop and maintain positive working relationships with agencies and systems, ability to work with minimum supervision and as part of a team. Excellent communication and organizational skills; ability to work flexible hours (some evening and weekend hours required); as well as availability to travel. Knowledge of, and/or experience in, the mental health field would be an asset.
