Complete psychosocial assessments, develop individual needs assessments, and community support plans, Provide institutional and community based support services as required, Coordinate client services through collaboration with other agencies, Monitor, record and evaluate the achievement of client goals, Participate in program development and improvement activities.

Bachelor of Social Work Degree from an accredited university. Registered in good standing with the Newfoundland and Labrador Association of Social Workers.
